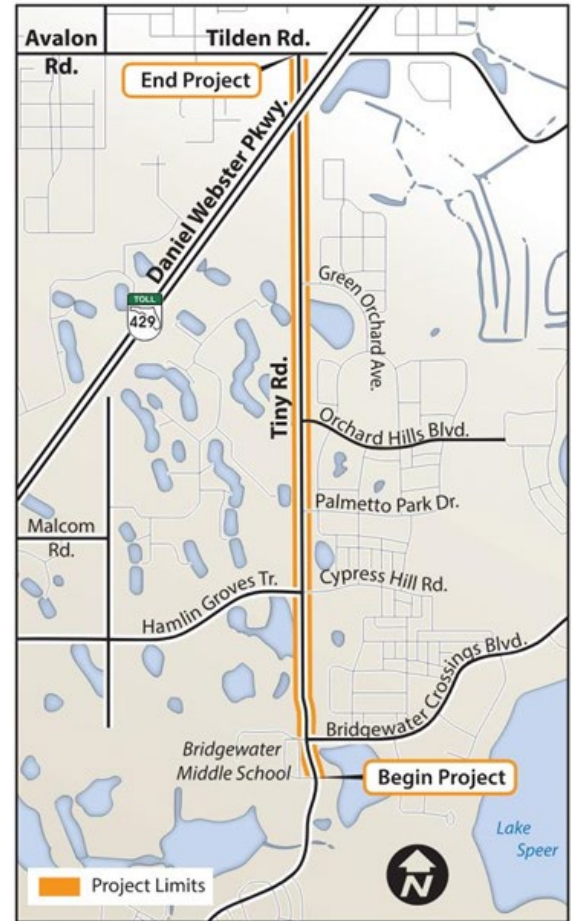
LPA & BCC Hearings Scheduled

Orange County is finalizing a Roadway Conceptual Analysis (RCA) Study to recommend multimodal improvements to the existing two-lane, approximately 2.0-mile section of Tiny Road, from just south of Bridgewater Middle school to Tilden Road.

The RCA Study recommended plan would provide two 11-foot-wide travel lanes separated by a 22-foot-wide raised median, a 10-foot-wide shared-use path on both sides of the road, improved lighting and landscaping, and grade changes to improve visibility. Intersection improvements include roundabouts at key intersections, pedestrian hybrid beacons, and a raised crosswalk at Bridgewater Middle School.

The RCA Study involves significant data collection, including current and future traffic volumes, current and future land use along the corridor, and right of way needs. The study also involves thorough environmental analysis to evaluate potential impacts to protected and endangered species, wetlands, or other natural resources.

The public will have two opportunities to provide public comment at upcoming Public Hearings before the Orange County Planning & Zoning Commission and the Board of County Commissioners. Details about the date, time and location of the hearings are listed below.

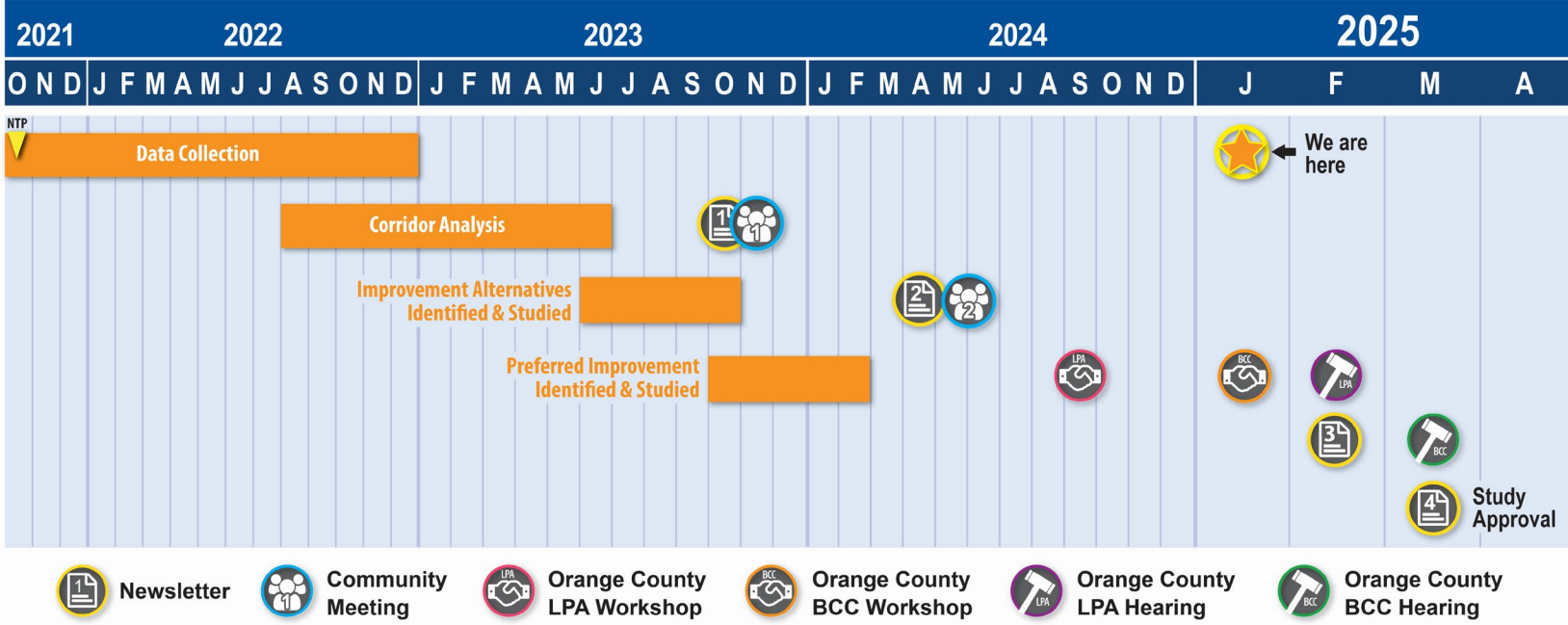
